Program overview

EMTP is designed and delivered by The University of Queensland's Institute of Continuing & TESOL Education (ICTE-UQ). The program enables English language teachers who have a language background other than English to

- Receive insights into creative and innovative methodology appropriate for teaching English to learners from elementary to advanced levels
- Explore new resources and materials appropriate for the ESOL classroom context
- Enhance their own English language skills.

EMTP is ideal for English language teachers at primary, secondary or higher education levels. Program benefits include:

- Tuition by highly qualified and experienced native-speaker English language teachers/teacher trainers
- An opportunity to explore new approaches to and methodologies for the teaching of English
- An opportunity to build motivation and confidence using English in the classroom
- Cross-cultural awareness training and strategies as an integral part of English language teaching in an international context
- An opportunity to observe the Australian classroom environment and the application of English teaching methodologies through organised school visits

Program content

EMTP participants receive 25 hours of tuition per week, divided into approximately 75% development of applied methodology skills and 25% intensive English language development for TESOL Purposes. Program content is designed to develop participants' communicative competence and proficiency skills in a TESOL context, with a focus on:

- Intensive development of English language fluency in the four macro skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing, with a principal focus on speaking and listening
- Development of awareness and familiarisation with communicative teaching methodologies
- Development of and practice in strategies to promote classroom teaching and learning
- Practical use of multimedia to develop skills for use in the language classroom and for teachers' professional development purposes
- Micro-teaching and materials development

EMTP Fixed Date Program

ICTE-UQ delivers a 3-week fixed date, mixed nationality EMTP program each year. Enrolment is open to individuals or small groups.

The EMTP fixed date program provides an opportunity for program participants to meet with fellow TESOL colleagues and undertake professional development training in a multicultural learning environment. Individual class sizes are limited to between 12 and 18 participants.

2016 Program Dates: Monday 25 July – Friday 12 August 2016

2016 Program Fee: AUD\$ 1,470

Homestay accommodation is available for EMTP fixed date program participants in 2016 for a weekly rate of AUD\$250 plus a once-off placement fee of AUD\$250. Airport reception on arrival is available for AUD\$110 (Brisbane domestic or international airport).

EMTP Group Programs

EMTP programs for groups can be customised to suit individual client needs. Customised EMTP programs for bilingual teachers of other subjects are also available.

Programs are available for groups of 14-18 participants and are typically 3-8 weeks in duration. Program dates are negotiable however programs should be timed to suit the Queensland school terms to allow for school visits.

In addition to EMTP program delivery, ICTE-UQ can also coordinate a range of additional half-day, full-day and weekend cultural activities, return airport transfers and homestay or self-contained apartment style accommodation.
