A popular way to travel in Taiwan is by rail. Lines stretch for 2,000km across the island, and the country is one of only 20 in the world that has a high speed rail system. Taiwan's first lines were constructed in the 1890s by the Chinese, but the railways were rebuilt and greatly expanded by the Japanese colonial government that followed. Indeed, much of what the Japanese accomplished in the first half of the 20th century can still be seen in Taiwan today. One example is the Alishan Mountain Forest Railway that was originally created in 1912 so as to transport wood. However, the Forest Railway has become somewhat of a tourist attraction since then. This is due in part to the beautiful views that can be observed, but also its winding Z-shaped tracks, as well as the more than 50 tunnels and 77 wooden bridges that dominate the line. In fact, it is considered so important that the government has listed it as a potential World Heritage Site. Annually, over 230,000 Taiwanese rely on the railway to deliver them to various destinations across the island. But the railway is just one of many examples reflecting how much the country has developed in a relatively short space of time.

The Watergate scandal (水門案) was one of the worst political scandals in US history. In 1972, some men who wanted to get President Richard Nixon re-elected decided to spy on the other party. They broke into their offices so as to obtain photographs of secret documents. Even though they got away with it at first, they were caught when they tried to break in again.

The government tried to cover up the break-in. In interviews, President Nixon acted as if he had no knowledge of the activities and sought to persuade people that he was not involved. Nixon was re-elected president in November 1972 because he seemed sincere. In the meantime, two reporters were looking into the break-in. They had a source inside a government department who told them that the president was involved. They discovered that Nixon had promised money to the thieves as long as they kept quiet and had also used his power to try and stop the FBI from examining the case.

Even though doubts about the president's guilt were spreading, there wasn't any real proof. In time, though, recordings of Nixon's conversations were discovered. These recordings clearly showed that Nixon had at least been involved in a cover-up. Nixon's political career was over as soon as the recordings were released. On August 9, 1974, President Nixon became the first US president to quit.

President Nixon was not arrested, although many of the other men involved were caught by the police. A total of 48 government officials were found guilty of the crimes and many were sent to jail.
