For one, it can be burned to get rid of mosquitoes. Another way their dung can be used is for beer. Some people may already know that elephant dung can be used to make coffee. But not many people know that it can also be used to make beer! This type of beer is named after the Japanese word for dung and is made by fermenting* the dung into beer. The flavor is similar to that of coffee – soft and sweet. Last but not least, elephant dung can also be used as medicine. Since their dung comes from plants and vegetables, it is useful for relieving* pain. Therefore, it can be burned and breathed in through the nose to relieve headaches. So it is surprising to know that elephant dung can actually be useful!
